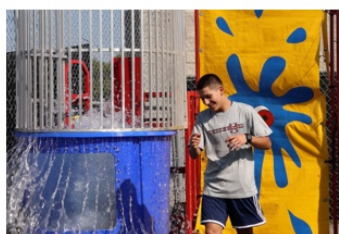

# Past Events *Spotlight*

## Major Post Season Play for TUSC

This summer proved to be quite competitive for TUSC teams as they continue to reach new levels of success.



**2008 Girls SCCL** - By finishing as State Finalists at the TSSA State Cup, the team qualified for the US Youth Soccer Southern Regional Championships held in Murfreesboro, Tennessee this year where they played teams from Oklahoma and Texas. Although they did not make the finals the team had a great showing with one win and two ties. Straight back to training the girls went in preparation for the US Club Soccer National Championships in Commerce City, Colorado July 14-21. They faced tough competition from Minnesota, California, Texas, and Illinois. Win after win, the girls dominated all the way to the semi finals where they lost 1-2 in a heartbreaker against FC Lake County.



**2009 Girls SCCL** - Also traveling to Commerce City, Colorado in July were the 2009 Girls SCCL as they qualified for the US Club Soccer National Championships after a monster first season in the Southeastern Club Champions League (SCCL). Teams from Texas, New Jersey, and Colorado awaited the girls. Although they finished their tournament with one tie and two losses, the appearance alone was a success to build on.



**2007 Boys NPL** - The team enjoyed a very productive first season in the South Atlantic Premier League Division of the National Premier Leagues. So much so the boys qualified for the NPL Boys East Playoffs in Bermuda Run, North Carolina in June. Over three games against teams from Kentucky and Florida they went 2-0-1, but fell short in the knock out round by one goal in a 0-1 loss to Wake FC.
